POSITIVE SENTENCES	
I am clever.	I' m clever.
You are beautiful.	You' re beautiful.
He is young.	He' s young.
She is tall.	She' s tall.
We are polite.	We' re polite.
You are diligent students.	You' re diligent students.
They are thin.	They' re skinny.

NEGATIVE SENTENCES	
I am not stupid.	I' m not stupid.
You are not ugly.	You' re not ugly.
He is not old.	He' s not old.
She is not short.	She' s not short.
We are not impolite.	We' re not impolite.
You are not lazy.	You' re not lazy, are you?
They are not big.	They' re not fat.

ASKING QUESTIONS

POSITIVE SENTENCE	QUESTION	NEGATION
She is a teacher.	Is she a teacher?	No, she is not a teacher.
They are at school.	Are they at school?	No, they are not at school.
